

## WADEBRIDGE TOWN COUNCIL CEMETERY FEES EFFECTIVE FROM 1 APRIL 2023

(Fees reflect The Social Fund (Children's Funeral Fund for England)
Regulations 2019

Fees, Payments and Sums fixed and settled under Article 15 of the Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977 (no.204).

#### Guidance

- Memorial tablets are not permitted on burial plots;
- ➤ For memorials erected on a grave space purchased solely for the interment of cremated remains, a maximum of six inscriptions will be permitted. Inscriptions to the front and rear of the headstone will be permitted.
- All tablet memorials will be laid flush to earth level by Council Staff.
- > Fees are payable in advance.
- > The transfer of an exclusive right of burial where the rightful owner has made an application is £35 for both Parishioner and Non-Parishioner.
- > Fees vary depending on whether the deceased is either a Parishioner or Non-Parishioner. A Parishioner is as defined below.
- ➤ CHILDREN AGED 18 YEARS AND UNDER PARISHIONER AND NON-PARISHIONER, No cemetery fees will apply for children aged 18 years and under, including a stillborn child (as defined in The Social Fund (Children's Funeral Fund for England) Regulations 2019

#### **Definition of a PARISHIONER**

#### A Parishioner is someone who:

- Is normally resident within the Wadebridge or Egloshayle Parish boundary;
- Had been normally resident within the Wadebridge or Egloshayle Parish boundary within FIVE years of the date of death;
- Purchased the exclusive right to the grave space while a resident of either Wadebridge or Egloshayle Parish.

Second interment – of cremated remains (Town Council staff to excavate)	140*
CREMATED REMAINS IN A GRAVE SPACE - Where a plot is purchased with the intention of having more than two interments, families are requested to discuss this with the Funeral Director	
Purchase of a plot for cremated remains – to include first interment of the cremated remains of a person (by an undertaker or the family)	320*
Further interments of cremated remains – a fee will apply to all interments after the first (by an undertaker or the family):  • Single depth – maximum of three interments (per interment)  • Double depth – maximum of six interments (per interment)	140*
Interment of cremated remains by Town Council staff (where an undertaker or the family are not present) – where Town Council staff have been asked to undertake the interment on behalf of the family and additional fee will apply	80*

MEMORIAL GARDEN	
These fees <i>include</i> the Exclusive Right of Burial which will be issued at the time of purchase and excavation of plot. All interments within the Memorial Garden are undertaken by town council staff.	£
<b>Purchase of a single or double depth plot</b> – to include first interment of cremated remains of a person	160
Second interment of cremated remains - in a double depth plot	140

MEMORIAL FEES (Headstones and Tablets)	£
Headstone Memorials Permission to site a headstone in the burial ground (this fee will be applied to the first and all additional inscriptions) – simple designs/styles which may incorporate provision for flower vases The size of the headstone must not exceed 2ft 6 inches by 3ft high	100
Tablet memorials Permission to site a tablet in the memorial garden (this fee will be applied to the first and second inscription to include laying of tablet by town council staff)	135
The size of the tablet must be 15 inches by 12 inches. Integral flower vases are NOT permitted – a separate flower vase to be placed in the border above the plots will be permitted

Purchase of a single or double depth plot – to include first interment of the body of a person	570
Second interment – of the body of a person in a double depth plot	230
Second interment – of cremated remains (Town Council staff to excavate)	280*
CREMATED REMAINS IN A GRAVE SPACE - Where a plot is purchased with the intention of having more than two interments, families are requested to discuss this with the Funeral Director	
Purchase of a plot for cremated remains – to include first interment of the cremated remains of a person (by an undertaker or the family)	640*
Further interments of cremated remains – a fee will apply to all interments after the first (by an undertaker or the family):  • Single depth – maximum of three interments (per interment)  • Double depth – maximum of six interments (per interment)	280*
Interment of cremated remains by Town Council staff (where an undertaker or the family are not present) – where Town Council staff have been asked to undertake the interment on behalf of the family and additional fee will apply	160*

MEMORIAL GARDEN  These fees <i>include</i> the Exclusive Right of Burial which will be issued at the time of purchase and excavation of plot. All interments within the Memorial Garden are undertaken by town council staff.	£
Purchase of a single or double depth plot – to include first interment of cremated remains for a person more than 12 years of age	320
Second interment of cremated remains - in a double depth plot	280

**Please note**: Where interment is of cremated remains the excavation fee is included and will be undertaken by Town Council staff.

MEMORIAL FEES (Headstones and Tablets)	£
Headstone Memorials Permission to site a headstone in the burial ground (this fee will be applied to the first and all additional inscriptions) – simple designs/styles which may incorporate provision for flower vases.  The size of the headstone must not exceed 2ft 6 inches by 3ft high	200
Tablet memorials  Permission to site a tablet in the memorial garden (this fee will be applied to the first and second inscription to include laying of tablet by town council staff)	270
The size of the tablet must be 15 inches by 12 inches. Integral flower vases are NOT permitted – a separate flower vase to be placed in the border above the plots will be permitted
