Fin 274/21 Finance

a) Budget monitoring figures to 30 November 2021

The figures were reviewed, and members **RESOLVED** to accept the budget monitoring figures as presented.

b) Bank Reconciliation to 30 November 2021

The figures were reviewed, and members **RESOLVED** to accept the bank reconciliation figures as presented.

Fin 275/21 Precept 2022/23 – Members viewed the Draft Budget as presented.

 The Council's budget has been managed carefully since the beginning of COVID 19. This has been, and continues to be, an uncertain time however the Council has a healthy budget to move into next year with several projects now coming to fruition.

The Town Council's estimated overall revenue budget (excluding reserves) has increased by approx. £17.8K for 2022/23.

The projections for 2022/23 are made with a view that COVID measures will not have the financial impact seen in 2020/21.

This small budget increase is due to the anticipated increase in income for parking, rents and room hires which COVID 19 impacted upon in 2021/22 and which have offset any departmental increase in expenditure.

- Projected general reserves are increased slightly.
- Specific reserves have increased by £105K.
- Projected income has been estimated prudently.
- There are now no Business Rates payable on properties considering wholly or mainly of public toilets due to the Non-Domestic Rating (Public Lavatories) Bill. A refund was received for those rates part paid in 2021/22.
- It has not been confirmed whether the Town Council will be subject to Council Tax referendum principles this year.
- Council Tax Base 2021/22 Band D equivalent figure was 2,371.68. For 2022/23 this figure has increased by 81.55 (3.4%) to 2,453.23.
- CTSG Advised figure of £7,075.32 for 2022/23 this is a reduction of 75.3% since 2016/17. 2022/23 is the final year that Cornwall Council will pay the CTS grant.
- It is recommended within the Local Government Finance Act1992, Section's 32,43 & 50 that a contingency of 3-12 months of general reserves be held. A minimum level of reserves for 2022/23 is recommended at £304K which equates to 3.75 months expenditure and is within the guidelines.
- It was **RESOLVED** to **RECOMMEND to FULL COUNCIL** to accept a precept figure of £568,975 for 2022/23 (8.5% increase on the 2020/21 precept figure of £524,401)
- Members noted that this will have a corresponding 4.89% increase on a Band D property of £10.82 per year or 21p per week.
