The Dogs on Leads (Egloshayle Playing Fields, Jubilee Field and Lower Jubilee Car Park and surrounding path) Order of 2012

The Wadebridge Town Council hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order comes into force on the 7 January 2013
- 2. This order applies to the land specified in Schedule 1 which is outlined in red

Offence

- 3. (1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time specified in Schedule 2, on any land to which this Order applies he does not keep the dog on a lead of not more than 5 metres in length, unless –
 (a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
 (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so.
 - (2) For the purposes of this article a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

Penalty

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

SCHEDULE 1

The Order applies to land at Egloshayle Playing Fields, Jubilee Field and Lower Jubilee Car Park and surrounding path which is shown outlined in red on the plan attached to the Order and which is open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment).

For the purposes of this Schedule, any land which is covered is to be treated as land which is "open to the air" if it is open to the air on at least one side.
